- All school & education groups must book in advance.
- A minimum £40 non-refundable deposit per class is required to confirm all bookings.
- There is a minimum charge of £70 per class for all workshops and talks.
- Norton Priory is a safe place to visit and all of our workshops are risk assessed. However, we recommend schools and education groups undertake their own risk assessments.
- Classrooms available for packed lunches. There is a café on site for teaching & supervising staff to purchase hot drinks and other refreshments.
- One adult is admitted free of charge for every six children. One-to-one carers are free. Additional adults will be charged the usual admission rate.
- Coach parking at the museum.
- There is an onsite shop or you can pre-order goody bags.
